


hen I first visited Hawaii in 1979, I knew that I had found my happy place, my spiritual island. It was in Hawaii, sitting on the beach, enjoying the sunset, and thinking of a way to travel the world, that I envisioned Cirque du Soleil. I've always loved Island communities, as they are often spiritual and very connected to nature. Surprisingly, French Polynesia wasn't my first choice when I began looking for an island of my own. In 2007, negotiations failed for an island in Bora Bora, but on my way back, a friend told me about Nukutepipi. When I walked across its forest and saw the magnificence of the turquoise lagoon, I knew this island would be the lucky one! This atoll is untouched and free of mosquitoes. It's a bird sanctuary and home to one of the last primary forests in the Tuamotus. A true paradise. This island found me, not the other way around. It was love at first sight! Nukutepipi surprised me with its incredible sunsets, full of colors I had never seen before, and the fact that its distance from the mainland makes you humble, realizing that you are a grain of sand in the universe.

Before doing anything, it was very important for me to understand the island, its ecosystem, and its relationship with the ocean, according to the different seasons. We first studied the jewel we had in our hands, then we cleared the island of certain invasive plant species. Just before the first stage of the construction, which lasted about

8 years, a large swell came on the island. We decided to listen to nature as it helped us refine the island's design. The island's construction is now completed, although we'll always be adding new features, to support functionality and technical elements. Preserving natural resources and nature is essential, and every effort is made to achieve this. It's a priority that we don't take lightly.

Searching for treasures is my passion. I love collaborating on magical places, so that I can share them with people. Nukutepipi reflects my vision and personality. It's a unique place to see the incredible spectacle of nature unfolding that also respects the island's wildlife and purity. Over time, we've developed a creative program that highlights the art, beauty, and spirituality of the Polynesian culture. It's the perfect place for those seeking a memorable, human experience in a warm setting. Come and see for yourself!

ar out in the Pacific Ocean, where human impact fades away and nature takes center stage, there is an exclusive private island destination unlike any other place on earth. The sunsets contain colors beyond imagination and the water glistens like the most precious aquamarine gemstones. Here, as if by magic, the milky way appears within reach. This is Nukutepipi, the crown jewel of French Polynesia, developed under the careful eye of its owner, French-Canadian businessman and Cirque du Soleil Founder Guy Laliberté. It was a coup de coeur, a blow to the heart, when he first laid eyes on the island more than 15 years ago, he says, and he set out to create a dazzling escape that would honor his love for its unparalleled beauty.

Years in the making, Nukutepipi is ready to share, its carefully constructed bungalows and villas integrating harmoniously into the landscape, creating a luxurious hideaway that celebrates and protects its stunning setting. Equipped with either a king or two queen beds and private terraces, the 13 bungalows gaze upon the island's turquoise lagoon and pure white sand. A pair of two-bedroom junior villas, ideal for families, feature airy living space, direct access to a private infinity pool, and breathtaking lagoon views. At the heart of the island, with panoramic lagoon and sunset views, is the master villa-a complex unto itself with two bedrooms, two additional one-bedroom bungalows, a private infinity pool, Jacuzzi, and cinema room.

Equally important are the island operations behind the scenes. From water usage and solar batteries to the fruit and vegetable gardens, greenhouses, and small farm, the island is a model of self-efficiency and sustainability. "Nukutepipi is an extraordinary laboratory that educates us and makes us learn about the strength and the organic process of nature," Laliberté says. Despite its remote locale, a dizzying array of activities are available to guests of all ages and curated to excite and inspire everyone from adventure lovers to those seeking total relaxation. Among the watersports are wakeboarding, wake surfing, paddleboarding, windsurfing, kayaking, deep-sea or reef fishing, and sailing. The snorkeling and scuba diving are firstrate, given the tropical fish-filled reefs near the island, and tours also are offered of its rainbow-hued coral gardens. Whales frolic nearby from July to November, adding to the natural wonders. Land-based activities also are abundant, including tennis, badminton, mini golf, beach volleyball, basketball, pickleball, archery, and yoga. Birdwatching and beekeeping connect visitors with the island's ecosystem. And, when it's time for pampering, a full spa awaits. A private stateof-the-art music studio, which has hosted industry icons, is accessible on demand. The cultural influence is omnipresent and can be experienced through Polynesian canoeing, weaving, or learning to hand dye a traditional pareo. There are even hermit crab races! When night falls, the on-island observatory brings the moon and stars right into your living room.

This Pacific Ocean paradise is located less than 650 miles from Tahiti, which provides direct flight access from major international cities. Nukutepipi also can accommodate up to 50 guests for weddings or other special celebrations that deserve a one-of-a-kind private island. "Our signature is the hospitality we offer, which is more community-based and encourages sharing in all its forms," Laliberté says. "Nukutepipi is a unique place, a masterpiece of nature, a pure joy, a treasure to discover as a couple, family, or group."

ocated in the highly desirable Sans Souci cottage community of Ontario's Georgian Bay, Daisy Island has always had a lot going for it, including total privacy, spectacular open-water sunset views, a sheltered deep-water harbor, and close proximity to the region's social hub, Frying Pan Island. Then in 2018, a complete renovation of the island by the highly regarded builder Tamarack North, with all interior spaces created by Sarah Richardson Design, took things to the next level, giving the main house a beautiful "cottage chic" vibe, upgrading all infrastructure, and adding two stylish new guesthouses. Along with the original one-bedroom bunkie, the 2.85-acre island has five bedrooms that can sleep 10, making it the ultimate ready-forrelaxing family compound.

The island's entirely refurbished 800-squarefoot cedar one-bedroom main cottage features a showstopping designer kitchen with top-end built-in appliances and windows on three sides of the room that flood it with light throughout the day and offer gorgeous water and interior island views. The living/ dining room is warmed by a classic floor-to-ceiling wood-burning stone fireplace, while the master suite has a three-piece ensuite and laundry alcove.

The two new Ray Murakami-designed guest cottages boast floor-to-ceiling sliding glass, which affords dramatic views over the water and seamlessly blends indoors and out. Each cottage is 540 square feet and has a living room and three-piece bath, while one has one bedroom and the other has two. Sited along the western waterfront, the guest cottages are linked by boardwalks and granite stone pathways, but discreetly separated for privacy. All-new infrastructure on the island includes hydro, septic installation, plumbing, decks, and a Kropf floating dock system at the harbor. Daisy Island and all its turnkey beauty are easily accessible from marinas in the Parry Sound basin, just about two hours' drive north of Toronto via Highway 400.

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


n the Parry Sound District of Georgian Bay, the most common sounds are bird calls and breeze rustling the evergreens. Summertime brings together family and friends for leisurely outings on the bay or laid-back days on one of the many islands dotting these placid waters. Beginning next summer season, a high-end island rental compound on a 7.14-acre private island will deliver front-row access to this region's serene beauty. Burritts Island, ensconced in a secluded stretch of the bay south of Byng Inlet, is accessible only via boat and takes cottage living and entertaining to new heights.

William Dewson of Toronto's Dewson Architects designed the island's five-building compound to complement the surrounding water and boreal forest of the Canadian Shield. The timber structures are Douglas fir from western Canada and the finishes are locally sourced spruce, birch, maple, pine, and walnut, giving the property a warm glow. The main cabin's central living space cantilevers over Burritts Inlet to provide sweeping sunrise and sunset views, as well as southern exposure throughout the day. A massive granite fireplace, its stone mirroring the gray bedrock that forms the island, anchors this area. Its three-bedroom, three-bathroom wing is tucked away into the trees beyond, featuring a king bedroom with ensuite, plus a queen bedroom and twin bedroom with bathrooms across the hall. Capacity more than doubles with the four-bedroom, two-bathroom guest cabin and a bunkie that adds another queen bedroom and half bathroom. A fire tower and a utility cabin complete the expansive property.

Monthly rental of Burritts Island starts at CAD 50,000 and includes island hopping excursions, fishing trips, and boat service for the 30-minute journey to and from the marina in Britt, seven miles away. A flotilla of kayaks, canoes, and paddleboards also are provided to make the most of the surrounding waterways, and swimming is easily accessible from the front dock. A waterside wood-burning sauna invites total relaxation.

n Western Port Bay, southeast of the captivating Australian metropolis of Melbourne, Elizabeth Island offers a secluded private retreat less than two hours from one of the world's most vibrant, sophisticated cities. Consisting of approximately 65 acres on freehold title, nearly 2 miles of coastline and rising to approximately 60 feet above sea level, the private island includes two homes that have been eco-designed for easy remote living. The main house, built in 2004, has three bedrooms, two bathrooms, and a veranda surrounding it. The home faces north to views over the red cliff face of French Island National Park, and skies with everchanging hues of yellow, orange, red, and purple. Privately situated 650 feet from the main house is a fully self-contained villa with two bedrooms and two bathrooms, built in 2022 and offering views from a higher perch over the island's northern point and Elizabeth Bluff. Ample infrastructure comfortably supplies power, water, and drainage to the houses, and access to major mobile networks for TV, phone, and internet communications. Current zoning also offers the possibility of more dwellings.

Spectacular sunsets start and end every day on Elizabeth Island. Many waterbird species make their homes nearby, and can be seen feeding off the wetlands, wandering around the shoreline, or flying overhead. Offshore are seals, dolphins, and even the odd whale. The deep channel off the southern part of the island attracts numerous fish species.

The island's jetty and mooring put you within easy reach of the nearby ports of Corinella, San Remo and Hastings on the mainland, and Rhyll on Phillip Island, 90 minutes from Melbourne. Store your boat at the Phillip Island Marina, where staff will put it in the water for your trip to Elizabeth Island after you load your supplies. Take your car onto the island by barge from Corinella. Land even more quickly onto your private Australian paradise via helicopter from one of the heliports near Melbourne's airport, central business district, or closer to the island.

Centuries later, Little Raccoon Key has been kept unspoiled in hopes of preserving the same natural beauty that was enjoyed by the Timucua tribe so many years ago.

In recent years, Little Raccoon Key has been named by the luxury travel world as one of the country's best glamping destinations, appearing in outlets like Travel + Leisure, Oprah Daily, and Forbes. Glamping has allowed the current owners to share the natural beauty of the island while focusing on the ongoing conservation of the wildlife and plant species found here.

From its tranquil perch inside the park on Schroon Lake, Brill Island gazes upon the Adirondack Mountains, offering a hideaway from the world with front-row access to outdoor adventures. The call of nesting loons and morning mist rising from the water add to the island's idyllic landscape.

Ideal for a family getaway or group retreat, this six-acre private island rental property features a trio of accommodation options. Nestled within Brill Island's pine, birch and maple trees is a six-bedroom, 4.5-bathroom main house with lakefront porch, cozy living room with fireplace, and open-plan dining room with chef's kitchen. It's only a five-minute boat ride to the mainland car park in Pottersville, N.Y., the jumping off point to explore scenic Schroon Lake town 10 miles north, with its swimming beach, hiking and biking trails, and delicious dining options. Lake Placid, Saratoga, and the Albany airport are no more than 75 minutes away. Conveniently located midway between New York City and Montreal, Brill Island opens the Adirondacks while giving visitors the privacy to bask in its beauty.

Set between Spanish Cay and Manjack Cay in the Sea of Abaco, Powell Cay is just three miles northeast of the village of Coopers Town, one of the northernmost settlements on Great Abaco.

With a total footprint of approximately 294 acres, Powell Cay's southern 168 acres are owned by the Crown and are set aside for a proposed nature reserve. This makes the island's other 126 acres on its north end the ideal location for a boutique resort or peaceful private retreat. This portion of the cay lies in an approximate northwest to southeast orientation, with the northern side having an Atlantic Ocean exposure and the lee side facing the Sea of Abaco with relative protection. The northern beaches are typical of Atlantic exposure, with green mature trees and shrubs fringed with white sands sweeping along the coastline, all offering incredible views of the various blue and turquoise hues of the ocean and sea.

While offering complete tranquility, Powell Cay is also conveniently close to a nice selection of amenities and services. Just one island to the north is Spanish Cay with its beautiful and popular resort and marina, while directly across the Sea of Abaco on Great Abaco is Coopers Town, a quaint hamlet with just under 700 permanent residents and a small selection of restaurants, medical services, and other facilities. Just half an hour's drive southeast of Coopers Town is the slightly bigger Treasure Cay, while just 45 minutes away is Marsh Harbour, the largest town in The Abacos with nearly 6,300 permanent residents.
